

Watch the road and grass for route markings. This marking indicates that the POWER riders (pink) have a left turn coming up.



From Scenic Heights Rd in Oak Harbor, riders for the following routes will turn down a gravel path on their right (see other demonstrations).

POWER, Century 100, Century Half 50 (white), Metric Half 33

When the path concludes, this marking will show you the way to the Whidbey Island Bank Breakstation (to the left!). Riders can also skip the breakstation, and continue to the right.





From Scenic Heights Rd in Oak Harbor, riders for the following routes will turn down a gravel path on their right.

POWER, **Century 100**, Century Half 50 (white), **Metric Half 33**

Watch for paint markings on the road, orange safety cones, and for this guy! Right after riders see this guy, the gravel path will be coming up on the right.



Here are examples of the paint markings which indicate paths to follow, based on individual routes. Here are all the route colors:

Metric Half 33: GREEN (3)

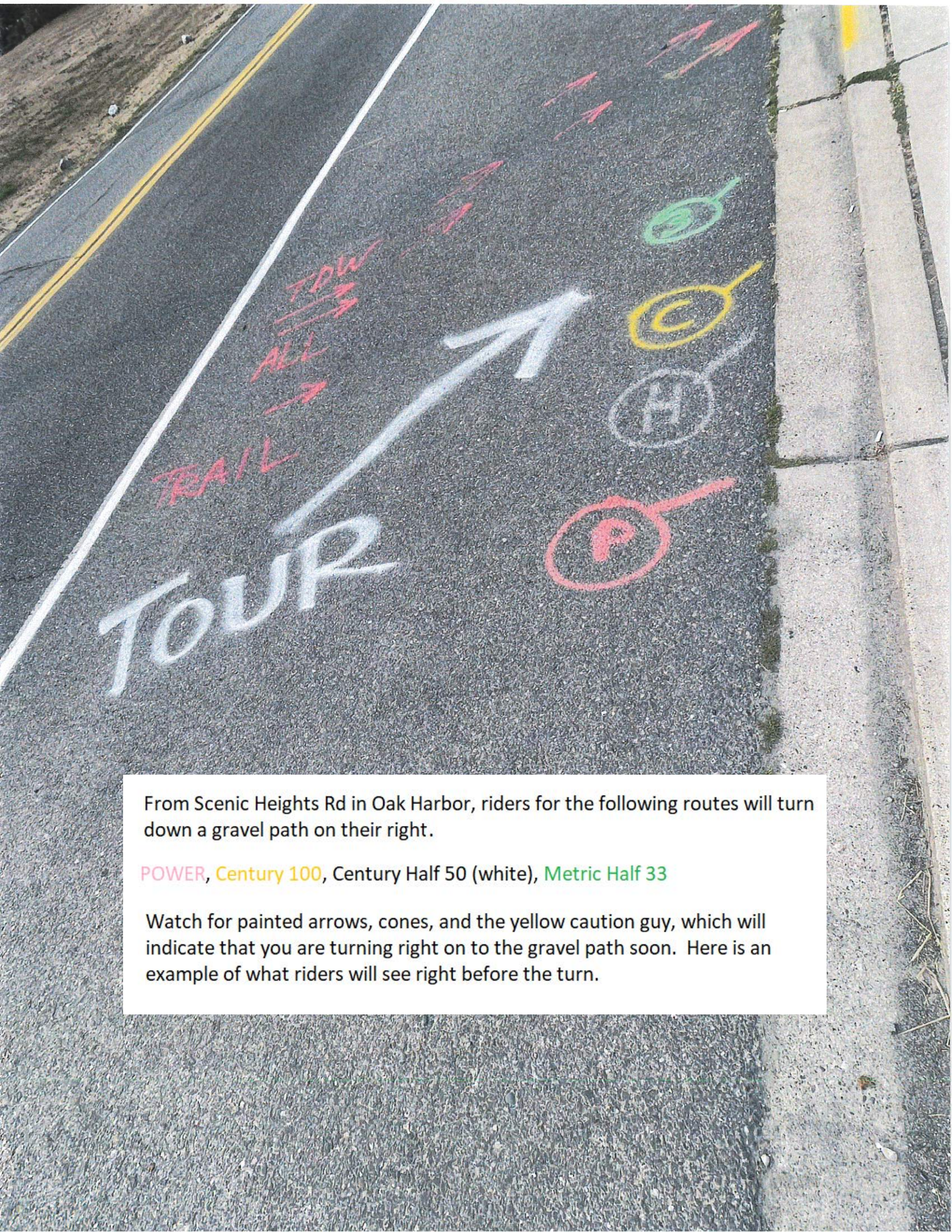
Half Century: WHITE (H)

From Scenic Heights Rd in Oak Harbor, riders for the following routes will turn down a gravel path on their right.

POWER, **Century 100**, Century Half 50 (white), **Metric Half 33**

Watch for painted arrows, cones, and the yellow caution guy, which will indicate that you are turning right on to the gravel path soon. Here is an example of what riders will see right before the turn.
